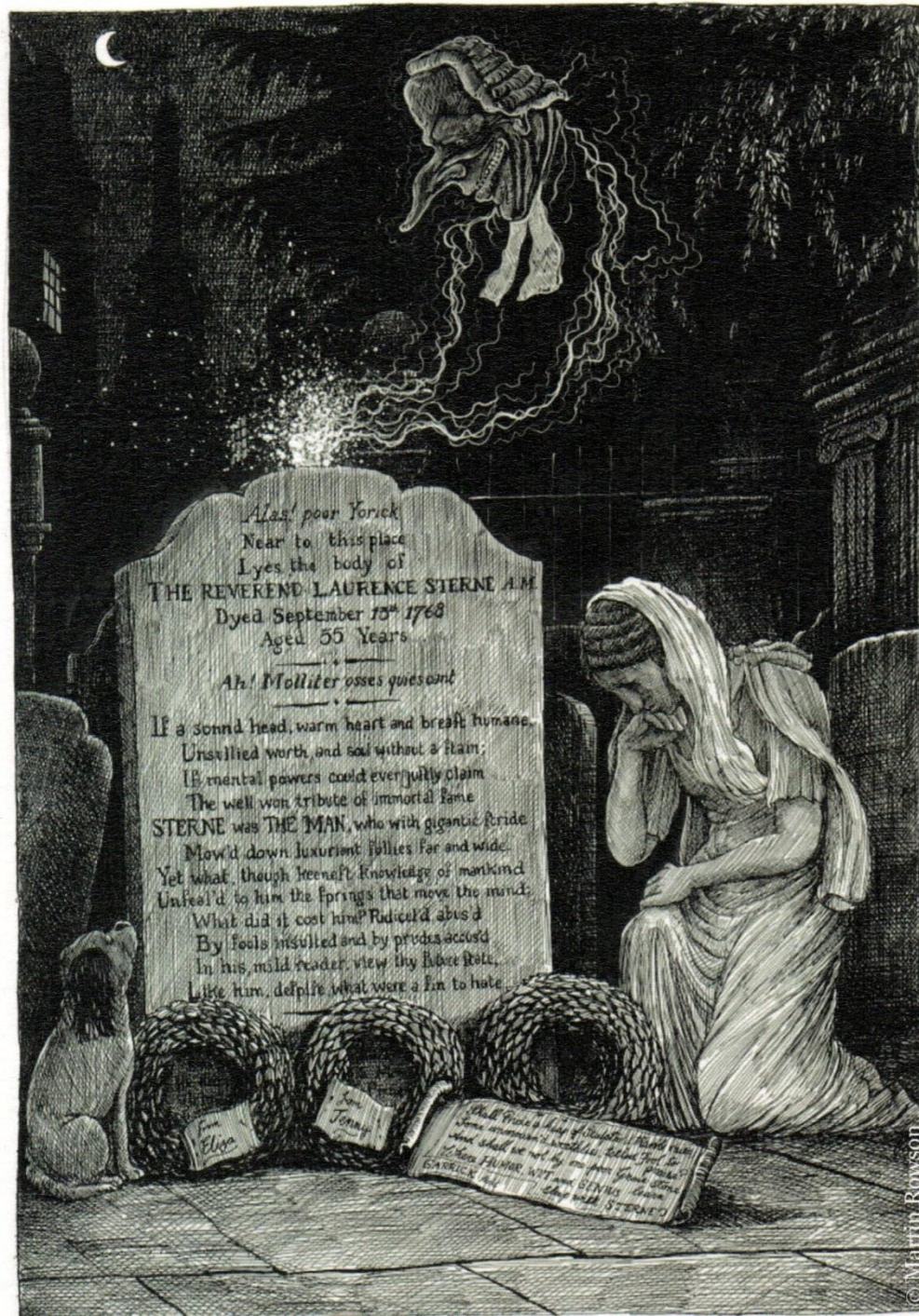


ALAS POOR YORICK
